



SPRING 2020 STATISTICS

This semester the Division of Global Engagement welcomed 495 students from 73 different countries to UL Lafayette.

The number of nations represented on campus jumped from 69 to 73 when students from Antigua & Barbuda, Bolivia, Dominican Republic, Gabon & Pakistan enrolled.

Students graduating in the Spring 2020 semester can apply for OPT with the DGE as early as February 15, 2020 through July 7, 2020.





TAX INFORMATION

All undergraduate and graduate students who were physically present in the U.S in F or J status anytime between January 1 – December 31, 2019 are required to send Form 8843 before April 15, 2020 to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), even if no income was earned. Students who earned \$1 of U.S source income or greater during 2019 must file a federal tax return (Form 1040NR) and a state of Louisiana tax return. The Division of Global Engagement partners with Sprintax, a company that specializes in non-resident tax preparation. Please be sure to check your university email as our office will soon send information to all F and J students with step-by-step instructions on how to use Sprintax tax preparation software. To learn more about the U.S. tax system and understand your tax filing obligations, please attend our next International Hour Tax Information Session on February 14th located in the IEP Building (413 Brook Avenue).

The Campus Cupboard is a resource for UL Lafayette students who require short-term assistance to meet their food needs.

The pantry provides free, nonperishable items to students. It's located in UL Lafayette's Intensive English Program building at 413 Brook Avenue next to The Saint Street Inn. This is an organization that thrives with volunteer support. The Campus Cupboard is open on Tuesdays from 3:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. Wednesdays from 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. and on Fridays from 10:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Students who visit the Campus Cupboard will be asked to present their University IDs.
